COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

OLD TESTAMENT INTRODUCTION

THIS COURSE IS A HISTORICAL-THEMATIC SURVEY OF THE OLD TESTAMENT. IT FOCUSES ON THE CONTENT OF THE OLD TESTAMENT, WITH EMPHASIS ON THE CULTURAL, HISTORICAL, AND GEOGRAPHICAL BACKGROUND TO THE TEXT AND THE PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF MAJOR OLD TESTAMENT THEMES. REQUIRES STUDENTS TO REACH THROUGH THE OLD TESTAMENT. (ARTICULATION AVAILABLE)

NEW TESTAMENT INTRODUCTION

THIS COURSE IS A HISTORICAL-THEMATIC SURVEY OF THE NEW TESTAMENT. IT FOCUSES ON THE CONTENT OF THE NEW TESTAMENT, WITH EMPHASIS ON THE CULTURAL, HISTORICAL, AND GEOGRAPHICAL BACKGROUND TO THE TEXT AND THE PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF MAJOR NEW TESTAMENT THEMES. REQUIRES STUDENTS TO REACH THROUGH THE NEW TESTAMENT. (ARTICULATION AVAILABLE)

BIBLICAL INTERPRETATION

THIS COURSE INTRODUCES STUDENTS TO THE ISSUES AND METHODS OF BIBLICAL INTERPRETATION USING THE HISTORICAL-GRAMMATICAL METHOD. IT WILL ADDRESS MATTERS AS PRESUPPOSITIONS, HISTORICAL CONTEXT, GRAMMAR OF TEXTS, GENRE, WORD STUDIES, AND MIGRATING THE ORIGINAL MESSAGE OF THE TEXT INTO OUR CURRENT DAY WORLD. (ARTICULATION AVAILABLE)



COURSE DESCRIPTIONS (CONT.)

SYSTEMATIC THEOLOGY I

THIS COURSE COVERS THE METHODOLOGY, HISTORY, AND BASIC ISSUES SURROUNDING SYSTEMATIC THEOLOGY (SUCH AS UNITY VS. DIVERSITY AND CONTINUITY VS. DISCONTINUITY). THIS APPROACH WILL BE UTILIZED TO TRACE KEY ELEMENTS OF THE BIBLE: GOD, AGELS, HUMANITY. COMMENTARY WILL COVER SOME FACTORS IN THESE ELEMENTS (GOD, TRIUNITY, MISSION OF THE SPIRIT, ETC.) (ARTICULATION AVAILABLE)

SYSTEMATIC THEOLOGY II

THIS COURSE DEVELOPS THE STUDENTS' ABILITY TO THINK THEOLOGICALLY AND INTRODUCES THE DOCTRINES OF SOTERIOLOGY (SALVATION AND GROWTH), BIBLIOLOGY (SCRIPTURE), ECCLESIOLOGY (CHURCH), AND ESCHATOLOGY (LAST THINGS). (ARTICULATION AVAILABLE)

MISSIOLOGY

THIS COURSE WILL INTRODUVE THE STUDENT TO THE MISSIO DEI, AND THE CHURCH'S PART IN GOD'S MISSION. "MISSIO DEI" IS THE IDEA THAT GOD IS ACTIVELY WORKING TO RESTORE HIS CREATION TO HIMSELF. THE STUDENT WILL LEARN ABOUT THE MISSIONAL GOD, HIS GOSPEL, AND CALL FOR DISCIPLESHIP. (ARTICULATION AVAILABLE)



COURSE DESCRIPTIONS (CONT.)

COUNSELING & COMMUNICATION

THIS COURSE WILL INTRODUCE STUDENTS TO METHODS AND PRACTICE ON COMMUNICATING MORE EFFECTIVELY, LISTENING MORE EMPATHETICALLY, UNDERSTANDING MORE SELFLESSLY, AND CONNECTING MORE EMOTIONALLY. TIME WILL BE GIVING TO PRACTICING AND CRITIQUING EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION AND GENUINE DIALOGUE. (ARTICULATION AVAILABLE)

COMPOSITION

THIS COURSE INTRODUCES THE STUDENT TO FOCUSING ON THE BASIC, FUNDAMENTAL SKILLS OF GRAMMAR COMPOSITION. TRADITIONAL WORKTEXTS WILL BE USED TO ALSO HELP DEVELOP STUDENTS' ANALYTICAL THINKING SKILLS, WRITING SKILLS, RESEARCH SKILLS, AND ORGANIZATION SKILLS. (ARTICULATION NOT AVAILABLE)

LIFE IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

THIS COURSE PRESENTS SCRIPTURAL TRUTHS AND CONVICTIONS OF LIFE IN THE SPIRIT, AND HOW HE LEADS US AND TAUGHT BY PRECEPTS AND EXAMPLES. THE COURSE IS A PENTECOSTAL UNDERSTANDING OF THE BIBLICAL TESTIMONY FOR WHAT FOLLOWERS OF CHRIST SHOULD BELIEVE AND LIVE OUR LIVES ENGAGED BY THE SPIRIT. (ARTICULATION NOT AVAILABLE)



COURSE DESCRIPTIONS (CONT.)

KC DNA

THIS COURSE EXPLORES THE ESSENCE OF OUR CHURCH'S IDENTITY IN "KC DNA," A CLASS DELVING INTO OUR DISTINCTIVE VALUES, ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURES, AND MISSION. UNCOVER THE CORE PRINCIPLES SHAPING OUR COMMUNITY, EXPLAINING WHY WE DO THINGS A CERTAIN WAY AND HIGHLIGHTING WHAT SETS US APART FROM OTHER CHURCHES. ENGAGE WITH OUR UNIQUE IDENTITY AND DISCOVER THE REASONS BEHIND OUR PRACTICES, TAILORED SPECIFICALLY FOR STUDENTS JOINING OUR SCHOOL OF MINISTRY, WHETHER YOU'RE A SEASONED MEMBER OR NEW TO OUR CONGREGATION. (ARTICULATION NOT AVAILABLE)

KC INT

THIS COURSE ALLOWS STUDENTS TO EMBARK ON A TRANSFORMATIVE JOURNEY OF CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT AND HONING ESSENTIAL MINISTRY SKILLS. EXPLORE FOUNDATIONAL PRINCIPLES OF INTEGRITY, EMPATHY, AND LEADERSHIP, EQUIPPING YOURSELF TO SERVE WITH EXCELLENCE AND COMPASSION. THROUGH PRACTICAL EXERCISES AND INSIGHTFUL TEACHINGS, CULTIVATE THE CHARACTER TRAITS AND PRACTICAL ABILITIES NECESSARY FOR EFFECTIVE MINISTRY IN DIVERSE CONTEXTS. (ARTICULATION NOT AVAILABLE)



CLASSCREDITS 8 ARTICULATION

Students are guaranteed 24 credits (8 classes) if they complete the program. As noted above, besides the academic courses students may receive up to 30 credit hours for knowledge gained through "non-college courses, on the job training, or personal studies." This might include learning from Wednesday classes and ministry training.

Our articulation agreement with ORU involves the university accepting all completed academic classes passed at an acceptable grade, which will be applied toward a degree with the university. Course transfers will be reviewed and evaluated based on the ORU Course and Instructor Qualification Policies and Guidelines. Additionally, through ORU's prior learning assessment process, adult learners may receive up to 30 hours of credit for knowledge gained through non-college courses, on-the-job training, or personal studies. This is in addition to the articulated courses transferring from KSM.

MINISTRY INTERNSHIPS

Ministry is undoubtedly a hands-on learning experience. At King's, we recognize the value of practical immersion in understanding the dynamics of church operations. As a first-year student, you'll embark on a rotation of internship tracks designed to provide a comprehensive view of the inner workings that enable the church to thrive. Drawing from the wealth of practical wisdom accumulated by our seasoned pastors, ministers, and leaders, you'll have the invaluable opportunity to serve alongside and glean insights from these veterans of ministry. Aligned with King's pillar structure, the internship track ensures a well-rounded training experience, enabling you to delve into various aspects of ministry. Each student will have the chance to apply for a semesterlong internship in their area of interest. Moreover, complementing their chosen ministry track, students will also receive training from our Administration and Experience teams. In their second year, students will transition to a more focused study in their chosen area of ministry, allowing them to cultivate expertise in their desired field. This shift in focus will deepen their understanding and proficiency, preparing them for effective service in their future roles.

ROOM & BOARD

Housing at the Olinda property on the slopes of Haleakala is available for fulltime students ages 18 to 29. The housing package includes three meals a day and transportation to and from church. This housing arrangement enables students within this age range to fully engage in the discipleship experience and ministry training that KSM has to offer, without the necessity of employment.




In 1980, Dr. Marocco was led by God to move to Maui to pastor First Assembly of God in Kahului, a church with a congregation of 100 people. That first Sunday in May - his first official service as the pastor - our church doubled. Within a year, we had grown to 700 people attending the Sunday morning services. Although the chapel on Kane Street had been expanded in attempts to accommodate the growth, God opened the door for us to secure the Maui Skate Palace which became our home in 1982.

In 1983, God spoke a word to Dr. Marocco that changed his life and our church forever. The Lord said, "Just as the mayor of Maui County is the mayor of three islands, I want you to pastor three islands." That year we started our first extension on Moloka'i, soon to be followed by an extension on Lana'i. This led to the concept of being one church not only in three locations but in many congregations as we expanded to other sites on Maui.

In 1984, God spoke to Dr. Marocco to secure 14 acres on the most trafficked corner of Maui. Ten Years later, after numerous miracles, we moved into our new church home: the largest church facility in the state of Hawaii. 19

In 1999, Dr. Marocco stepped into a Times Supermarket in the Niu Valley Shopping Center on O'ahu and prayed, "Father, if you want me to build a church in East Honolulu, give us this property." What followed was another series of Miracles and in 2002, after the purchase of the shopping center, we began the construction of our Niu Valley Campus. During that same time a congregation began to meet at Niu Valley Middle School, and in 2006 we moved into our Niu Valley facility in what was formerly the Times Super Market.

IN THE MAKING

Jesus Loves You

By 2005, we were in the 12/12/12 Vision, believing God to be in 12 nations, 12 places in the continental United States and 12 new campuses in Hawaii. By 2010, the vision grew, and we embraced the 120/20 Vision, believing to be one church with 120 congregations ministering to 20,000 people weekly by May of 2015.

Then God expended us further as we embarked on the 1-2-3 vision, to be fulfilled by 2020: 100 more churches in the United States, 200 more internationally, and 30,00 disciples worldwide. Subsequently, God directed us into Vision 500 in which we believed God to be one church in 500 locations by May of 2021.

In addition to having Campuses on Maui, Moloka'i, Lana'i, Hawai'i, Kaua'i, and Oʻahu. our Mainland United States include Alaska, locations Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Indiana, lowa, Indiana, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, Oklahoma, Oregon, Texas, Utah, Washington, and West Virginia. Furthermore, we are now in 17 nations around the world including Brazil, Canada, Chile, Fiji, Italy, Japan, Malaysia, the Marshal Islands, Mexico, Mozambique, the Philippines, New Zealand, Tahiti, Tonga, Spain, Venezuela, and Vietnam.




EXPERIENCE LIFE
